





CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR LPG SUBSIDY SCHEME

Uganda aspires to increase the share of clean energy used for cooking from 15% in 2018/19 to 50% by 2025. In line with this aspiration, the government plans to distribute 1 million LPG cylinders between 2022 and 2027 to increase LPG access from 1% to 20% by 2030.

government Building on this initiative commenced 2022. Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (UN-FAO), in collaboration with the Ministry of Water and Environment (MWE) and the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Development (MEMD), will be implementing an LPG subsidy scheme targeting teachers in government aided secondary schools in (i) Luweero district (ii) Gulu city and (iii) Arua City. Through this scheme, eligible beneficiaries will acquire subsidized 6kg gas full kit (cylinder filled with 6kg of gas and fitted with burner and grill).

This is to invite eligible applicants.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Should be a citizen of Uganda and above 18 years of age
- Should be in active employment as a TEACHER IN A GOVERNMENT AIDED SECONDARY SCHOOL located in target geographical location (Luweero district, Arua city or Gulu city).
- 3) Should not currently have LPG connection.
- 4) Should be able and willing to contribute at least Uganda shillings fifty thousand (Ugx 50 000), towards the cost of the LPG Kit (cylinder filled with 6kg of gas and fitted with burner and grill).

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Filled and signed application form with all required attachments
- Copy of valid personal identification e.g., National ID, Passport, or any other personal identification document officially issued by relevant authority.
- Application forms MUST be endorsed by respective School Head Teacher.
